# GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Read **2 Chronicles 34:19-21, 23-25**. When Josiah heard the Word of God, he discovered the sins of the nation were great. Where has our nation gone spiritually? What are areas we have gone away from God's Word that we need to repent of?
- 2) Read **2 Chronicles 34:14-18**. The Book of the Law found in the temple was more than likely the Book of Deuteronomy. This Book gave Josiah and the people direction on making reforms and covenant renewal. How can seeking God's Word stir up revival?
- 3) Read **2 Chronicles 34:19, 27**. When Josiah heard the Word of God, he tore his clothes and humbly wept over his and his nation's sins, and then dismantled idols and destroyed the wicked around him. What sin do you need to confess and turn from?
- 4) Read **2 Chronicles 34:20-28**. Josiah told his attendants to inquire of the Lord by asking information from a prophetess. Why is prayer so important when it comes to revival? Spend some time in prayer now that God will bring about revival in our nation.
- 5) Read **2 Chronicles 34:29-31**. All the people from the least to the greatest gathered to hear the Word of God. Josiah called the leaders and all the people came too. How can you reach out to others and share your faith? Who can you share your faith to?
- 6) Read **2 Chronicles 34:32**. The people of God pledged themselves to follow God and keep His commands. Why is it essential for believers to unify with one another? How can you unite with other Christians at Christ Covenant and in other churches?
- 7) Read **2 Chronicles 34:33**. All who were present served the Lord, and as long as Josiah lived, they did not fail to follow God. What do you need to do to persevere with faithfulness?

- 1) Memorize **Psalms 119:37** - *Turn my eyes away from worthless things; preserve my life according to your word.*
- 2) Spend some time talking with your family about what a revival is and why we need one.
- 3) Read **2 Chronicles 34:14-33** with your family. Discuss the 6 ways to stir up revival.
